

Press Release Passenger's Statistics February 2008.

Arriving and departing passenger traffic at Hato International Airport was up 33.7% in February 2008 compared with February 2007 and up 52.16% over February 2006, according to Curacao Airport Partners (CAP). Airlift as measured by total arriving and departing capacity in aircraft seats was up 14.3% over February last year indicating that aircraft load factors on average continue to increase.

CAP noted that for the first two months of 2008 airlift capacity to Amsterdam is down about 3,000 seats since KLM was still flying the B747 during this period in 2007 but that total outbound passenger traffic has increased by 1,827 passengers resulting in an average load factor for the route of 98%.

Although there was good growth in all major markets, CAP reported that traffic to Venezuelan points accounted for two thirds of the increased traffic. Others markets demonstrating healthy year to date growth thru February as measured by outbound passengers include Aruba up 15%, Bogota up 50%, Miami up 15% and Sint Maarten up 21%. During this period new weekly service was inaugurated by Delta to Atlanta.

Transit/transfer traffic was down largely the result of KLM providing direct service and no longer circling flights to Curacao thru Aruba and Sint Maarten
